

# **Okanagan Hare Scrambles Series**

## **Rules and Regulations**

### **Competition Committee:**

1. The Committee is to be made of one member from each sponsoring Group to represent the Group at all meetings and each Series event
2. There will be no pre-riding courses as early as two weeks before the event unless deemed okay by the host Group organizers. Check PN web site for any change by host Group. With out the correct okay you could risk an imposed 1 race throw away. This is to minimize HOME track advantage.
3. This is a 6 race series with one throw away (which can be used for a number of things and reasons). It will be the best out of 5 for all Classes.
4. They must be able to listen to disputes in a quiet area and settle them to the best of their ability. The Host Group must stand behind their decisions. If an agreement cannot be made among those Committee members present at the event, the dispute can be tabled to a later meeting.
5. A Class must have 5 competitors to race and receive points for their Class.

## **Host Group:**

1. The host Group must give the points keeper \$2.00 per entry, a copy of the results sheet. The host Group is also responsible to sell PNWMA Competition Licenses to all riders.
2. The entry fee will be \$35.00 each for all 6 OHSS races.
3. Hare Scrambles courses should be 15 – 22K long and a total of 2.5 hours for “A” loop, with “B” loop riding 6 – 8K and a total of 1.5 hours. As a cut off guided line for host Group organizers at the lap counter station.
4. The morning before the race event there will be NO PIT RIDING AND NO ONE ON THE COURSE OTHER THAN THE ORGANIZERS. This is for every ones SAFTY.
5. A fully train First Aid person must be present at all events. If there is no First Aid, the event shall not go on for all concerned
6. Results must be posted half an hour before presentations, to allow disputes.
7. Pro Payout - will be at the year-end party. The payout will consist of the Pro Gate for the year minus

8% contributed towards the year-end party. Pay out will go to 1st, 2<sup>nd</sup> and 3rd placing.

8. Classes:

1. **Pro:** “A” loop - afternoon race
2. **Expert:** “A” loop - afternoon race
3. **Intermediates:** “A” loop - afternoon race
4. **Vet Expert:** age 30 – 39, “A” loop - afternoon race.
5. **Senior Expert:** age 39 – 49, “A” loop - afternoon
6. **Super Senior:** age 49 plus, Course “A / B” dependant on difficulty - afternoon race.
7. **Vet Amateur:** age 30 – 39, “B” loop – morning race.
8. **Senior Amateur:** age 39 – 49, “B” loop morning race.
9. **Ladies A:** Course “A /B” dependant on difficulty - morning race.
10. **Ladies B:** “B” loop - morning race.
11. **Junior Over 200 cc:** Course “A or B” dependant on difficulty - morning race.
12. **Junior Under 200 cc:** “B” loop - morning race.
13. **85 cc – Small Wheel:** “B” loop – morning race. (*parent many ride to help, but must stay clear of competitors*).

## **DCT Chambers Pee Wee Race Series:**

14. 65 cc Over, Pee Wee course, lunch break
  15. 65 cc Under Pee Wee course, lunch break

6. Riders must cross the finish line with the same bike they started with to get points. However, a rider who stops racing to assist someone injured will receive an averaged score (“Good Samaritan Points”). At the discretion of the Host Group and/or Committee.
  7. All courses are to be marked with arrows and wrong way markers, where arrows aren’t feasible, use ribbons. To prevent course cutting VIA “A, B” loops, you must have checkers at the junction to prevent confusion.

### **Point’s keeper:**

1. Points standings should be posted on the PNWMA/OHSS web site.
2. The Point’s keeper should consult the Competition Committee regarding any rider who, in his/her first race event of the Series, places in the top 20% of a higher class. That rider must move up one class.

3. There will be no tie breakers, in the event of a first place tie, two first place awards will be given, with the next score receiving third.
4. The OHSS Executive will arrange for the Awards Night and venue.
5. The points will be tallied according to the following system:

21st place and on will receive 1 point for completing the race. A riders best of 5 races will be totaled up for Okanagan Hare Scrambles Series Awards.

Awards for 1<sup>st</sup>, 2<sup>nd</sup> and 3<sup>rd</sup>.
