1.) Adopt minutes of last meeting: Approved.

2.) Old business

2.1) Calendar - Ted Blow - Still have a lost of the old ones. Should look at removing Clearbrook Yamaha for not paying. (Clearbrook did pay later so they're safe.) Change number for Scorpion Racing's number. Remove Vancouver Supermoto. (Also remove Jim Pattison Suzuki and Modern Motorcycling) Now print 1000 with RPM dates for distribution at RPM events.

3.) Correspondance - Deal with MBMC. They seem to want to pull out of the PN. They don't see many PN racers at their events but they don't want to pay the rider's fee. Currently they pay \$2.00 for all racers at their events. A suggestion was made for MBMC to pay a rider's levy just for the PN racer's attending their races.

4.) Points - Leanne Foreman - Not available (Pointskeeper was in jail at the time...mind you she works there.)

5.) Malcom Hett Fundraiser - Did it at the Roots of Doom race on the island. We gave money to Malcom Hett for support after wiping out at a US race. (Get Insurance!) Malcom would like to say thanks to the dirtbiking community.

6.) Rules - Shawn Dearden - Sound Decibel level test parameter from a static test to a mobile testing method similar to the one used by the FIM and AMA.

7.) New Business - Three Worlds / Dragon Spray - The GKMA changed the name of the Three Worlds to the Dragon Spray. The race is still the same format and the part of the PN series. The name change was done to take advantage to use of stuff from the cancelled Dragon Spray.

8.) Enviromental Guidelines - Bridges should be built across all creek crossings.

9.) Points System - The PN would like to purchase the FVDRA system for use as a back-up to the PN system. This way there will be a spare reader and more transponders. (Motion Passed)

10.) Laptops - PN would like to upgrade them from Vista to Windows 7. Laptops cannot use the race software with Vista. (Plus Vista sucks.) The old laptops will be sold for \$450 and purchase new ones.

11.) Calendar - Conflict with MBMC's Dirty Dog and GKMA's Dragon Spray. The issue to be discussed.

12.) Calendar - DSBC's 24 Hours of Church cancelled.

13.) Racing - Insurance and DOT Helmet enforcement is now up. Also do note that DOT helmets are mandatory at PN races. Mountain Bike helmets are not rated for the impact forces generated while wiping out on a motorcycle.

14.) Riding Area - Brohm and Cat Lake riding areas is now under development with the eventual loss of the riding area. (The SDBA has announced the return of their race in 2011, so all may not be lost.)

15.) PN Accounting - Tina Hansen has done an independent audit had checked the accounting for the PN and found all books are good.
